#### **CHAPTER 12.04**

#### **FAIRFIELD BAY PARK**

12.04.01 Quiet hours Quiet hours will be observed from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. daily. During quiet hours activities which interfere with the peace and quiet of the nearest campsite adjacent to your campsite are prohibited. Such activities include, but are not limited to, loud music, loud talk or large campfires. A warning by the park management or police will be issued for the first occurrence. If there is a second occurrence you will be instructed to leave the park. No refund of park fees will be made. (Ord. No. 02-11, Sec. 1.)

12.04.02 Speed limits Speed limits will be strictly enforced. Speeding tickets will be issued according to guidelines established by state law. Speed limit signs are posted throughout the park. (Ord. No. 02-11, Sec. 2.)

12.04.03 Alcoholic beverages Use of alcoholic beverages is controlled by state law. (Ord. No. 02-11, Sec. 3.)

12.04.04 Glass containers Glass containers are prohibited in or near the swimming and boat launch areas. Persons violating this section will be requested to remove glass containers from the area. Failure to do so will result in removal from the park. No refund of park fees will be made. (Ord. No. 02-11, Sec. 4.)

12.04.05 Laws and regulations All applicable laws and regulations of the state of Arkansas, U.S. Coast Guard, Arkansas Game and Fish Commission and the United States Army Corp of Engineers shall be observed and obeyed in the park area. A copy of title 36 CFR, Chapter III, Part 327 of the applicable Corps of Engineers Regulations is attached hereto. (Ord. No. 02-11, Sec. 5.)

12.04.06 Park enforcement The Park Manager shall be responsible for enforcing this ordinance. Upon refusal of park guests to comply, the Park Manager shall call the FFB Police Department for appropriate action. (Ord. No. 02-11, Sec. 6.)
